Bowel cancer is the second most common cancer affecting both males and females in Australia. However, 90% can be cured if detected early.

Ballarat Community Health, in partnership with Cancer Council Victoria, is offering free one-hour information sessions to community groups located in suburbs around Ballarat. The sessions are particularly relevant for people aged between 49 - 65 years, with the aim of encouraging those who are turning 50, 55 and 65 before December 2010 to participate in the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program. Information sessions will be available in English and other languages, and will occur from March to August 2010 only.

The information session will cover:

- The importance of healthy eating and regular physical activity in reducing the risk of bowel cancer
- The National Bowel Cancer Screening Program
- How to accurately complete a faecal occult blood test (FOBT)
