

School Health Programs – Sexual Health

Ballarat Community Health Centre offers *Sexual Health* sessions to secondary school students in years 7 – 12. These learning opportunities offer various class activities and discussion regarding decision making and consequences of sexual activity such as pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections.

Alternatively, Ballarat Community Health Centre can assist with worksheets, brochures or a DVD to support your school in providing sexual health education.

As research highlights the benefits of providing education in a holistic way, Ballarat Community Health Centre provides this program together with teachers and in line with VELS outcomes. This creates a supportive teaching and learning environment that can continue to be built upon beyond Ballarat Community Health Centre's involvement.

Additionally, Ballarat Community Health Centre provides opportunities for sexual health support for the wider Ballarat community through the provision of a sexual health clinic at our Sturt St site.
