Sexual Health Clinic

a confidential service

The Sexual Health Clinic provides confidential treatment and advice to men and women of all ages.

Health Promotion & Information

The Clinic, staffed by General Practitioners and Registered Nurses, can provide information on all aspects of health, including sexual health. Nurses are available for health promotion and education at schools and other groups.

Counselling

Confidential counselling is available.

Health Advice

- Pap smears
- Testicular checks
- PMS
- Fertility issues
- Menopause
- Breast care

Pregnancy

If you think you may be pregnant, the nurses at the Clinic provide pregnancy testing, counselling and advice, as well as referrals.

Contraception

Contraception is something you do or take to prevent pregnancy. There are many forms of contraception including:

- **Condoms** : Male & Female
- **The Pill** : Daily tablet
- **Dep-Provera** : 3 monthly injection
- **Implanon** : 3 yearly implant
- **Postinor** : Emergency contraception

Sexually Transmitted Infections

The Clinic provides **STI** testing, counselling and treatment. The most common sexually transmitted infections are:

- Chlamydia
- Genital Herpes
- Genital warts (HPV)
- Gonorrhoea
- Non Specific Urethritis (NSU)
- Trichomonas
- Hep B
- Hep C
- HIV

You may not know you have an STI – most people have no symptoms. Talk to the nurses at the Sexual Health Clinic.
